

Kingston Project Medical Screenings WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

After you sign-up for the screening, an ORAU representative will contact you by phone.

- The representative will schedule an appointment for you at Roane Medical Center in Harriman.
- A package will be mailed to your home. This package will contain:
 - A medical questionnaire
 - A consent form
 - A specimen cup
 - Directions to Roane Medical Center
- You will need to provide a first-morning urine sample the day of your appointment. Please arrive at the hospital with your medical questionnaire completed.

An ORAU representative will meet you at Roane Medical Center for your appointment.

- The representative will answer any questions you may have about the medical screening and will go over the consent form with you.
- A hospital staff member will escort you to each department during your appointment. You will go to:
 - Registration
 - Radiology for a chest x-ray
 - Respiratory for a breathing test (pulmonary function test)
 - Laboratory for urinalysis and blood work
- When your test results are complete:
 - ORAU will contact you and make an appointment to see the doctor.
 - If your results deserve urgent notification, you will be contacted accordingly.

You will have an appointment with a doctor from Vanderbilt University Medical Center:

- The doctor will see you in Kingston (ORAU staff will give you directions).
- During the visit, the doctor will:
 - Conduct a physical exam
 - Review your test results with you
 - Answer your questions
- After the visit:
 - The doctor will recommend next steps.
 - You will receive a letter with your test results and recommendations.
 - You can choose to share this information with your family doctor.
