Nomination Instructions

Deadline for nominations: November 1, 2010

Eligibility Requirements:

To be eligible, a student must

- (1) be a U.S. citizen enrolled at a university as a full-time student;
- (2) have completed by June 2011 two years but not more than four years of study toward a doctoral degree in physiology, medicine, or in a related field, including the basic biomedical (or life) sciences;
- (3) be participating in a research project funded by federal or private funds.

Number of Nominations per Institution:

A nomination should be initiated by the student's research mentor. Each institution may submit only *two* nominations to Mars, Inc.

Nomination Requirements:

The complete nomination includes (1) this form, (2) a one-page personal resumé of the student, (3) a one page statement by the student on why participation in the meeting is important for the student's graduate education, and (4) a one-page letter of reference by the student's mentor.

Nomination Process:

The student's mentor should transmit the nomination form through the official submission site - <https://www2.ornl.gov/lindaunomination/nomination.aspx>.

Deadline:

All official nomination packages must be submitted by 4:00 p.m. EST on Monday, November 1, 2010.

Notification Date:

Students being recommended to the Council for the Lindau Meeting for this program will be notified by December 1, 2010, using the contact information provided on the nomination form.
