Participant Insurance Communication for 2026

Dear Participant,

Through your educational appointment in the ORISE Research Participation Program, you are eligible to participate in certain insurance plans through Oak Ridge Associated Universities (ORAU). Please read the information below carefully, as it includes changes to currently offered insurance plans. You can also find this information on the Participant Insurance Website.

*Any insurance related changes will be effective January 1, 2026, and the Participant Insurance Website will update accordingly.

Medical, Prescription, Dental, Vision Plan Changes

There will be an increase to the Medical, Prescription, Dental, and Vision premiums for 2026.

Medical

There are minimal plan design changes to the medical plan for 2026. Medical insurance is provided by BlueCross BlueShield of TN.

- In-Network Out-of-Pocket maximum is increasing to \$4,000 / \$8,000
- Out-of-Network deductible is increasing to \$3,000 / \$6,000
- Out-of-Network Out-of-Pocket Maximum is increasing to \$12,000 / \$24,000
- Inpatient hospital stay copay is increasing to \$300
- Outpatient surgery copay is increasing to \$300

A quick reminder of the programs available through the ORAU medical plan for 2026:

- <u>Livongo Hypertension Management Program</u> Members with high blood pressure will be eligible to participate in the Livongo Hypertension Management Program by Teladoc Health. The program provides a connected blood pressure monitor and one-on-one support from expert coaches.
- <u>Healthy Maternity Program</u> Confidential maternity health advice and personalized one-on-one support from a maternity nurse. 24/7 Nurse line for general health-related questions.
- <u>Hinge Health Digital Musculoskeletal Program</u> aims to reduce pain, opioid use, and surgeries with claims across the musculoskeletal continuum: preventive, acute, chronic and surgery.
 Participate in the program at no cost.

Prescription

Prescription drug coverage will continue to be provided by CVS Caremark. The <u>2026 Advanced Control Formulary</u> and the <u>2026 Advanced Control Specialty Formulary</u> include the medications that will be covered and their associated tier. Starting 1/1/26, you will be able to fill a 30- or 90-day supply of your maintenance medications at any CVS, Kroger, or Costco pharmacy or through CVS Mail Order Pharmacy. Non-maintenance medications will be limited to a 30-day supply at retail pharmacies.

Dental and Vision

There are no plan design changes to the dental plan for 2026. Dental insurance is provided by Delta Dental of TN.

There are no plan design changes to the vision plan for 2026. Vision insurance is provided by VSP.

Participant Health Insurance Premiums Effective January 1, 2026

Monthly premiums will continue to be based on the number of eligible family members you choose to cover. Please note the Dental and Vision bundle is optional, but enrollment in the Medical and Prescription plan is required to enroll in the Dental and Vision bundle. You can choose to drop the Dental and Vision bundle according to the rules in the <u>FAQ</u> on the Participant Benefits Website.

Additional Details

Please review the information below regarding actions you may need to take for the 2026 insurance plans.

- 1. As a reminder, insurance enrollments and changes will be processed through the Compass Portal, by logging into your Zintellect account and navigating to the Health Insurance tab at the top of the page. Once you are directed to the Compass portal, you will select the appropriate event to begin your insurance enrollment or change.
- 2. If you are currently enrolled in the ORAU Medical and Prescription plans, and/or the Dental and Vision plans and you **do not** want to change your elections, no action is required on your part. Your premium will be updated automatically to reflect the 2026 premium changes.
- 3. If you wish to change your current insurance elections or covered dependents, normal health insurance guidelines apply. All insurance changes must be made through the Compass Portal. Please see the FAQ section of the Participant Benefits Website for questions.
- 4. If you would like to enroll or wish to cancel any ORAU insurance coverage, please contact your ORISE program point of contact and you will complete your insurance termination through the Zintellect portal by providing outside insurance coverage information.
- 5. Participation in the PAP program through TELUS Health occurs automatically and will be at no cost to you. No action is required to participate in this benefit.

^{1.} If you use an out-of-network provider, you will be responsible for any charges above the maximum allowed amount.

- o The plans pay the full cost of qualified in-network preventive health care services.
- You may have to pay a fixed dollar amount (**copay**) for certain services. Copays do not count towards your **deductible**. For other services that do not have a copay, you pay the full cost of non-preventive health care services until you meet the annual deductible. The deductibles on these plan are embedded.
- o Once you meet the deductible, you pay a percentage of certain health care expenses (coinsurance) and the plan pays the rest.
- Once your deductible, copays and coinsurance add up to the **out-of-pocket maximum**, the plan will pay 100 percent of all eligible covered services for the rest of the calendar year.

Prescription Insurance

CVS Caremark

In 2026, your prescription drug plan will be administered by CVS Caremark. The CVS Caremark network has over 60,000 retail and independent pharmacies and includes CVS Caremark Mail Service Pharmacy. To locate a network pharmacy, visit CVS Caremark Home.

How do I know if my drug is covered?

The complete CVS Caremark formulary (Advanced Control Formulary) is available at CVS Caremark Home. For your plan-

specific formulary drug coverage, log in to your member portal through the website and search by name for the medication.

Can I get a 90-day supply of my medication?

Yes, maintenance medications can be filled for a 90-day supply at any CVS, Kroger, or Costco* pharmacy or through CVS Caremark Mail Service Pharmacy.

How do I fill my specialty medication?

You will need to fill your prescription through CVS Specialty pharmacy. To order prescriptions through CVS Specialty, call 800-237-2767 or download the CVS Specialty Mobile App.

Hinge Health combines a clinical care team, advanced motion technology, and a wearable pain relief device. In addition, they have over 750,000 inperson providers ready to enable real-time interventions. The digital MSK program is available at no cost to members under the ORAU medical plan. Log-in to your bcbst.com account, go to Managing Your Health, and choose Digital MSK.

Hypertension Management Program by Livongo

Members with hypertension will be eligible to participate in the Livongo Hypertension Management Program. This program will provide personalized insights on your readings and support from expert coaches, all to help you take charge of your health.

Members who sign up for the program will receive at no cost:

- A connected blood pressure monitor
- > Step-by-step action plans based on your goals
- Tips on nutrition, activity and more
- One-on-one support from expert coaches

Log-in to your bcbst.com account, choose Managing Your Health, then Blood Pressure Management. Once eligibility has been confirmed, you will be shipped the Livongo Welcome Kit. You'll also be able to download and log in to the Livongo mobile app, where you can personalize your program and see your progress.

Healthy Maternity by BCBST

However, you will maximize your benefits and reduce your out-of-pocket costs if you choose a dentist who participates in the **Delta Dental of TN Premier** or **PPO network** (www.deltadentaltn.com).


Vision Insurance

You may also have to file your own claim if you go out-of-network.
