

INTRODUCTION TO THE FEDERAL CIVIL DEFENSE ADMINISTRATION
HIGH SCHOOL KIT OF RADIOLOGICAL INSTRUMENTS

This Kit contains the radiological instruments being distributed by the Federal Civil Defense Administration to High Schools. The container was designed to provide protection of instruments in shipment and can be used as a storage chest in the high school class room and provide limited security by attachment of a padlock.

Under existing law, title of these instruments is being transferred to your State although distribution is being made direct to the high schools. In the selection of your high school it was agreed that you would acknowledge receipt of this shipment to your State Director of Civil Defense and to the Federal Civil Defense Administration. Please follow these instructions:

1. Shipment to you is being made on a U. S. Government bill of lading and transportation charges are being paid for by this Administration. Upon receipt of shipment all you are required to do is fill out the "Consignee's Certificate of Delivery" at the bottom of the bill of lading and surrender it to the delivering carrier.
2. Three copies of FCDA Form 224 are enclosed in this Kit. Please check the contents of this Kit and execute block 22 of this form. Any discrepancies should be listed on the reverse side of the form. Forward two signed copies to the Federal Civil Defense Administration using the self-addressed envelope provided for this purpose.
3. There is enclosed a printed postal card provided for your convenience in acknowledging receipt of this shipment. Please fill in the blank spaces and mail this card to your State Director of Civil Defense.
4. Please read the enclosed Instruction Manual on Instrument Usage before attempting to use these instruments.
5. Upon completion of use of this equipment or discontinuance of the program at your high school, your State Director of Civil Defense should be contacted for disposition instructions of this Kit.
